0.15	Trail begins travel along Plateau Creek drainage.	
0.18	Trail crosses small stream, begins ascending at moderate grade.	
0.22	Trail ascends at very steep grade.	
0.23	Vegetation change.	Spruce/fir
0.38	Trail leaves aspen/spruce/fir enters open meadow.	Open meadow
0.45	Trail ascends at moderate grade.

2.00	Trail crosses Plateau Creek.	
2.10	Trail continues travel on west side of Plateau Creek.

2.57	High Trail forks away (right) from Plateau Creek drainage, begins heading west up steep hillside.

2.89	Trail continues to ascend at very steep grade.	
3.00	Trail enters spruce/fir.	Spruce/fir
3.12	Trail continues to climb at very steep grade.	
3.25	Trail offers scenic view of Plateau Creek drainage.	
3.39	Trail exits spruce/fir, begins travel in open meadow.	Open meadow
3.50	Trail travels at level/moderate grade in open meadow/scattered spruce/fir.	
4.03	Trail enters small stand spruce/fir at level grade.	Spruce/fir
4.05	Trail exits spruce/fir enters open meadow.	Open meadow
4.25	Trail travels through grassy meadow, bordered by spruce/fir stands.	
4.68	Trail continues travel in large grassy meadow. Leon Peak visible to southwest.	
5.85	Trail travels through seep area.	
6.25	Trail passes through small pocket of spruce/fir.	Spruce/fir
6.65	Trail crosses small muddy creek.	Open meadow
6.90	Trail crosses small, muddy creek, passes small pond on right side.	
7.38	Trail passes through muddy seep in pocket of spruce/fir.	Spruce/fir
7.45	Trail begins descending at moderate/steep grade.	Open meadow

7.52	Trail begins descent into Leon Creek drainage. Trail offers scenic view of Leon Creek.	
7.55	Trail descends at steep grade.	
7.65	Trail enters spruce/fir/aspen.	Spruce/fir/aspen
7.75	Trail crosses small muddy creek. Trail travels above Ranger Creek on side hill.	Open meadow
7.88	Trail is very rough due to steep grade.	
7.95	Trail continues through spruce/fir/aspen.	Spruce/fir/aspen
8.10	Trail leaves aspen/spruce/fir and continues in large meadow overlooking Leon Creek drainage.	Open meadow
8.12	Trail passes through barb-wire, wooden pole gate, begins travel along fenceline.	
8.22	Trail crosses small, dry creek bed.	
8.55	4X4 engraved trailhead post marks trailhead.	
8.57	High Trail ends, intersection with FDR # 262 (Park Creek Road).	Open meadow
