

## TRAIL FEATURES

<u>MILE</u>	<u>TRAIL FEATURE</u>	<u>VEGETATION</u>
0.0	Porter Mountain Trail forks left (south) off FDR #265.2C at edge of aspen stand as two-track, climbs at moderate grade toward treeline.	Open Meadow/Aspen
0.02	Trail climbs at steep grade toward aspen stand.	
0.07	Trail climbs at gradual grade in aspen and small clearings.	
0.20	Trail climbs at moderate grade in aspen stand.	
0.23	Wooden fenceline on west side of trail.	
0.40	Trail climbs at steep grade in aspen stand.	
0.53	Trail passes through wooden fenceline.	
0.56	Trail climbs at steep grade.	
0.64	Trail climbs at moderate grade.	
0.92	Trail climbs at gradual grade.	
0.93	Trail reaches intersection with Porter Cutoff Trail.	
1.02	Trail breaks out of aspen into meadow, moderate grade.	Open Meadow
2.05	Trail reaches intersection with two-track that forks right (west).	
2.18	Trail begins to climb at moderate grade.	
2.43	Trail climbs at steep grade.	
2.65	Trail passes small stock pond in drainage, climbs at steep grade.	
2.85	Trail climbs at steep grade.	
3.07	Trail climbs to ridge top above aspen stand, great view of surrounding country. West Elk Mts. visible to southeast, Bronco Knob to south, Buzzard Creek drainage to east.	
3.23	Porter Mt. Trail ends on top of Porter Mt. Great 360 degree view of surrounding country.
