



Shell Falls Wayside Medicine Wheel-Paintrock RD, Bighorn NF (Region 2)

This 2-phase project was designed by A/E firm Shapins and Associates (now Belt Collins) and Oz Architecture. Phase 1 was completed in 2008 and consisted of parking lot rehabilitation, plaza rehabilitation, new stone walls, railing upgrades, and the construction of a new Information Building and Bookstore. Phase 2 will be completed in 2011 and includes architectural upgrades to the existing restroom building, retaining wall replacement, rock wall repairs, and water system improvements.
