




Giant Knotweed

(*Polygonum cuspidatum*; *Fallopia japonica*)




Glossy Buckthorn

■ = common buckthorn




Purple Loosestrife

Phragmites (*Phragmites australis*)




Eurasian water-milfoil
(*Myriophyllum spicatum*)




