Recommendation Rationale					
<p>This species is disjunct in CO in southern Rocky Mountains. It's ranked S2 in CO – not found anywhere else in R2, although it is likely on MedBow NF (WY). It's very habitat-limited, found only in acid fens and bogs in CO. There are only 6 known occurrences in CO. These sites are unusually sensitive to animal or human use at any intensity. Acid fens and bogs in R2 are vulnerable to impacts from hiking trail use, off-road vehicle use, and changes in water quality and quantity on adjacent lands. Acid fens and bogs on private land are steadily declining from development, road building, and other disturbances.</p> <p>Due its disjunct nature, limited occurrence, and threats to it's habitat, we recommend this species be designated sensitive.</p>
