Annual Bob Marshall Complex Meeting to be Held April 9 in Choteau, MT

The public is invited to the annual spring meeting for the Bob Marshall Wilderness Complex on Saturday, April 9, 10am – 3pm, at the Choteau Public Library in Choteau, Montana.

The Bob Marshall Wilderness Complex, an area of more than 1.5 million acres, includes the Great Bear Wilderness, Bob Marshall Wilderness and the Scapegoat Wilderness. The complex is managed by four national forests, Flathead, Helena, Lewis and Clark, and Lolo National Forests.

For more than 20 years this meeting has taken place to share information among the various agencies and organizations that hold responsibilities related to the wilderness complex and the public. Representatives from the US Forest Service, Montana Fish, Wildlife and Parks and Bob Marshall Wilderness Foundation will be present.
