Approximate length: 2.2 miles

Etiquette and Rules

Motorized vehicles, mountain bikes and horses are not permitted on this trail.

Pack out your trash.

Safety

Use caution during hunting seasons. Blaze orange clothing is recommended during deer season (do not wear white).

If a parking lot is not available where you wish access, be sure your vehicle is well off the road. If you choose to use a road as part of your trip, be careful of traffic.

Ticks and chiggers are common. Take necessary precautions including avoiding tall grass and thick brushy areas.

Loose limbs and hazard trees can fall on the trail at anytime, especially on windy days.



A primitive campground with pit toilets is available. Saddle Lake has a boat-launching ramp and excellent fishing.



Directions

Take I-64 to IN 37 south (Exit 79). Take IN 37 south approximately 12 miles to the turn off on old Highway 37 to the Saddle Lake Recreation Area. Follow the signs to the boat ramp at the lake.



