

ORDER OF THE FOREST SUPERVISOR
SETTING FORTH RESTRICTIONS AND CONDITIONS OF USE
PIONEER MOTHERS' MEMORIAL FOREST OF THE
HOOSIER NATIONAL FOREST
TELL CITY RANGER DISTRICT

Pursuant to the Secretary of Agriculture's Regulations 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts or omissions are prohibited on the area, roads and trails within the Pioneer Mothers' Memorial Forest, Hoosier National Forest, Tell City Ranger District.

1. Use of a motorized vehicle on Forest development roads posted closed to all motorized vehicles. [36 CFR 261.54 (a)]
2. Use of a bicycle or motorized vehicle on all Forest development trails. [36 CFR 261.55 (b)]
3. Possessing or using a motorized vehicle off Forest development roads. [36 CFR 261.56]
4. Hunting or trapping. [36 CFR 261.58 (v)]
5. Riding, hitching, tethering, or hobbling a horse, or other saddle or pack animal. [36 CFR 261.58 (aa)]

These restrictions are necessary for public safety and to protect National Forest resources.

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any federal, state, or local officers involved in National Forest administration, law enforcement, search and rescue, or firefighting in performance of an official duty.

The Pioneer Mothers' Memorial Forest boundary is shown on the attached map.

Violation of the prohibitions of this Order are punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000.00 or imprisonment for not more than six (6) months or both under authority of 16 USC 551.
