Spring Prescribed Fire Projects Planned on Tally Lake District of Flathead National Forest

The Tally Lake Ranger District of the Flathead National Forest will be conducting prescribed fire projects this week, and continuing through the spring, as weather conditions are favorable. Smoke will be visible.

The Forest Service will be burning in the Bill, Lost, Cliff and Toby Creek Drainages, in the West Valley area west of Kalispell. The objectives of the burns are to reduce fuel loading created by harvest and fuels reduction projects and to promote regeneration of seedlings.

These burns are located and designed for their potential to be controlled and not escape as wildfires. These projects are in compliance with Montana Air Quality Standards and coordinated with Montana State Department of Environmental Quality.
