Recommendation Rationale					
Species is limited within R2 (four states—WY, SD, NE, KS), however, this represents a western extension of a wide eastern U.S. and Canada distribution. These populations are not disjunct but are on the periphery of the species' distribution. Species is rare to locally common in most woodlands, especially along streams. We do not feel that there is a regional viability concern, yet there may be concerns at the local level given that it appears to be infrequent here and occurs in habitats that may be adversely impacted by management actions. We recommend it be considered for other emphasis.
