

**Not R2 SS, But Should Be Considered for other  
Emphasis Species Lists**

**Recommendations and Evaluations**

**Common Name:** mountain draba

**Scientific Name:** *Draba rectifruca*

**Recommendation:** **Not R2 SS, be should be considered for other Emphasis Species Lists**

**Recommendation Rationale:**

--Regional endemic in UT, NM, AZ and CO, the latter being on the east edge of the range.

--Known from 9 counties in CO scattered across the west half of the state; S2 rank implies 20 or fewer occurrences in CO.

--Diverse habitat associations from 7,400-10,000 ft

--No apparent threat to viability on a region-wide basis and occurrence over several habitat types suggests some resilience. CO records indicate pops located near various land use activities, e.g. timber harvest, utility lines, roads, etc.

--Consider for local emphasis.
