

**Not R2 SS, But Should Be Considered for other
Emphasis Species Lists**

Recommendations and Evaluations

Common Name: Missouri foxtail cactus

Scientific Name: *Escobaria missouriensis* var. *missouriensis* (*Coryphantha missouriensis*)

Recommendation: **Not R2 SS, be should be considered for other Emphasis Species Lists**

Recommendation Rationale:

--This species is abundant on BGNG – Fall River District (B. Burkhart pers. comm.), particularly in clay pan types (SDNHP didn't submit review of this species).

--This species is likely more common on grasslands than expressed in evaluations for reasons expressed in those evaluations: inconspicuous species, a cactus, artifact of a lack of floristic inventory completeness, species with short-lived flowers, etc.).

Conclusion: this species doesn't warrant sensitive status but should be considered by individual forests for other emphasis species lists.
