

**ORDER**

**NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM ROADS**

**UMATILLA NATIONAL FOREST**

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area described in this order within the Umatilla National Forest, Monday thru Friday, until further notice.

1. Using any type of vehicle prohibited by the order. For the purpose of this order, this prohibition applies to motor vehicles being on the National Forest System road listed in Appendix A of this order (36 CFR 261.54(a)).

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571)

## **APPENDIX A**

National Forest System Road (NFSR) 2400190 from its junction with National Forest System Road (NFSR) 2400 to its terminus.

### **Supporting Documentation**

#### **Statement of Need:**

This is a narrow road with steep drop offs and the traffic is heavy. There is a current logging operation that utilizes this road. The conflict with the logging traffic and public traffic during Monday thru Friday operations creates a dangerous situation for public use.

#### **Enforcement Procedures:**

Only Law Enforcement Officers and Special Agents will conduct stops of moving vehicles to enforce these regulations. Forest Protection Officers may enforce the regulations by contacting violators once they have voluntarily stopped their vehicles. Officers will exercise discretion in the enforcement of this order, especially during its initial implementation phase.

#### **Posting:**

Signs stating that the road is closed to public use Monday thru Friday will be placed on the affected road at locations where the public could enter the road.
