

ORDER

UMATILLA NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area described in this order within the Umatilla National Forest, until further notice.

- 1) Operating a motorboat or other vessel on Olive Lake at or above a speed that causes a wake
36CFR 216.58(n)
- 2) operating a personal water craft (PWC) on Olive Lake **36CFR 261.58(n)**
- 3) Water Skiing on Olive Lake. **36 CFR 261.58 (o).**

For the purposes of this order the Olive Lake referred to is located on the Umatilla NF in the North Fork of the John Day District

Pursuant to 36 CFR, Sec. 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1.) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the prohibited act or omission.
- (2.) Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both. (16 U.S.C. 551 and 18 U.S.C. 3559 and 3571)

Supporting Documentation

Statement of Need: Olive Lake has numerous submerged trees and stumps making any travel by a motor boat at speeds greater than wakeless speed unsafe. Personal Watercraft create a high level of noise and have difficulty operating at speeds below wakeless.

Enforcement Procedures: Enforcement will primarily be handled by Law Enforcement Officers and Forest Protection Officer. Violation Notices or warning notices will be issued to persons who are seen in violation of either.

Posting: Will be posted and maintained by the district
