Recommendation Rationale					
<p>The species is found only in north central Colorado and southern Wyoming. This regional endemic to 15 counties has 10-20 occurrences in Wyoming and 35 in Colorado. Some populations number up to 1000 individuals. Three populations on the Med Bow NF. Threats are unknown. S1 in Wyoming. Tolerant of disturbance and indeed requires some disturbance. So, it is found, for example near road cuts, rocky hillsides, gravel and sand, granitic slopes, semi-barren openings in <i>Artemesia</i> . Populations appear stable. Keep a watch on the species through emphasis status.</p>
