Recommendation Rationale					
<p>In R2, this species is from southeastern Colorado. Outside R2, it has been reported in AZ, NM, OK, TX, AR, LA, and is listed by MO as S2. This tree/shrub occupies woodland margins, rocky hillsides, prairie ravines, and edges of fields and waste places. The species is on the periphery of its range here in R2. We do not see a high level of risk leading to a regional viability concern, but the species is uncommon here and we recommend that it be considered for other emphasis.</p>
