Recommendation Rationale					
<p>We recommend this species be considered for local emphasis (for north-central WY Forests) – 20 occurrences on the Bighorn with populations having 100 to 50,000 plants per site (“many of occurrences have tens of thousands of individuals); stable trend (high confidence rank); extremely rugged habitat (“deep wet limestone canyons”) and natural barriers; few threats. Water development could be a potential threat.</p>
