<p>This plant is found in southeast CO, southwest KS, throughout TX, OK and into northern Mexico; then west to AZ and NM. Very large populations have been located within R2 in se Co and sw KS on the Cimarron NG. This plants form “narrow uninterrupted stands up to a mile long.” Species is reported to recolonize disturbed sites and is relatively secure within the grasslands. Livestock grazing appears to have no affect of populations.</p>
