

## Not R2 Sensitive Species and Not of Concern

### Recommendations and Evaluations

**Common Name:** imperfect buckwheat

**Scientific Name:** *Eriogonum mancum*

**Recommendation:** Not R2 Sensitive Species and Not of Concern

### Recommendation Rationale:

This buckwheat is found within R2 in the Bighorn basin within Bighorn and Washakie counties. However, it does not occur on any R2 managed lands. It does not occur in other R2 states. It is known from 2 occurrences in Wyoming located 10 miles from a forest boundaries. Current threats to populations and habitats are unknown. Rangeland, this species is found in sagebrush flats and on grassy hillsides, often on calcareous soils.
