Recommendation Rationale					
<p>In R2, species is known in Wyoming from 2 extant and 1 historical record. In Colorado, it has been collected from nearly every high-elevation area in the state. Outside R2, it is known only from the Uinta Mountains of Utah. Species is widely distributed in the alpine and subalpine areas of Colorado. Habitat is rock slides and scree slopes in alpine conditions at 9000 to 13000 feet and is apparently stable. No threats to habitat or populations in Colorado. One population is in the Battle Mountain Research Natural Area in Wyoming and one is in the Rocky Mountain National Park in Colorado.</p>
