

Not R2 Sensitive Species and Not of Concern

Recommendations and Evaluations

Common Name: Chalk Hill hymenopappus

Scientific Name: *Hymenopappus tenuifolius*

Recommendation: Not R2 Sensitive Species and Not of Concern

Recommendation Rationale:

This species is found throughout the Great Plains in open sandy prairies and plains, and rocky calcareous hillsides. It's common in western KS and eastern CO, but is known from only 1 historical occurrence in the Bearlodge mountains of BHNF. It may be extirpated in WY. We recommend this species is not R2 sensitive and is not of concern. It is abundant within its expected range, including the appropriate R2 USFS lands.
