<p>Barry Johnston wrote: “ Twenty years ago, based on the work I did in my doctoral thesis, this plant appears to be an occasional genetic variation that is produced in normal populations of Potentilla concinna. I no longer consider var. bicrenata a valid taxon worth perpetuating.”</p> <p>The WY evaluators recognize this species as a distinct variety although intergrading does occur between var. concinna and var.bicrenata.</p>
