Recommendation Rationale					
<p>Evaluator gave five out of eight ranks of "D." Taxonomic difficulty with the perhaps ephemeral nature of the species makes determination uncertain. Species has not been seen outside of herbarium mounts for 65 years, having not been collected since 1937. It may intergrade with <i>I. rivularis</i>, a more common species distributed throughout Colorado. We do not know enough to be able to assess the viability of this species. The taxonomic problems and lack of knowledge about the biology, habitat, and populations can only be solved by rediscovery of historic element occurrences.</p>
