Recommendation Rationale					
<p>In R2, ten occurrences in Colorado, all but one from before 1955. Outside R2, species is known from New Mexico, where it is reportedly more abundant, and Utah, from herbarium specimens. Evaluator gives five of eight ranks of “D.” There are difficulties with the taxonomy and distribution. No one has studied the plant in Colorado, so little is known about population dynamics or sizes, or habitat limitations or preferences. More information is needed to assess the viability of this species in R2.</p>
