Recommendation Rationale						
<p>This plant is endemic to WY, occurring in the Absaroka, Wind River and Gros Ventre Ranges (G2). There are 11 occurrences in WY, with only one known occurrence on the Shoshone NF in the Washakie Wilderness. It is found along major rivers and streams where it occurs on gravel bars and cobble beds, in young cottonwood groves and dry stream channels at 6,400-7,300 ft. Population and habitat trends are not known. Threats potentially may include water diversions, gravel quarrying, invasion by nonnative plant species (e.g., knapweed), and hydrologic changes that reduce scouring. There is insufficient information available at this time to determine whether the species merits sensitive status.</p>
