<p>Endemic to the mountains of CO (G2?). It has been documented on the San Juan NF, and one herbarium record exists for the GMUG NF. Its habitat is openings in ponderosa pine forest and steeply sloping shale slopes at lower elevations. However, an evaluation was not done for this species, and therefore no information is available regarding population or habitat trends, or threats to the species other than its rarity. Therefore, there is insufficient information available to determine whether the species merits sensitive status.</p>
