## **APPENDIX C: ALTERNATIVE 4 UPPER TIER ACRES**

Table C-1 shows upper tier acres that are put forth in Alternative 4. Colorado Roadless Area upper tier acres are specific portions of or entire Colorado Roadless Areas that are identified in the set of forest roadless area maps maintained at the national office of the U.S. Forest Service. All road construction or reconstruction is prohibited on these acres except where needed pursuant to reserved or outstanding rights or as provided for by statute or treaty. Tree-cutting, sale, or removal is prohibited except for incidental to the implementation of a management activity not otherwise prohibited and as appropriate for personal or administrative use. Only the CRAs with upper tier acres for Alternative 4 are displayed.
