(For Public Safety)

PROHIBITIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), the following act is prohibited on the National Forest System area and road described in this order, within the administrative boundaries of the Mountain Home Ranger District, Boise National Forest. This Order will be in effect when signed and will remain in effect through April 18, 2011.

1. Being within the closed area (as described below). **36 CFR 261.53(e)**

EXEMPTIONS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a special use authorization or other Forest Service authorization specifically exempting them from the effect of this Order.
2. Any Federal, State, or local law enforcement officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Federal or State administrative personnel in the performance of an official duty.

AREA DESCRIPTION

The Lower Lava Mountain Closure Area is described as being on or within 500 feet of National Forest System Road #222 (aka Lower Lava Mountain Road) within Township 3 North, Range 7 East, Sections 26, 27, and 34, Boise Meridian.

The above described area and road is within the boundaries of the Mountain Home Ranger District, Boise National Forest, Boise Meridian, Elmore County, ID.

PURPOSE

The area is closed to all public access to provide for public safety.

IMPLEMENTATION

1. This Order will be in effect when signed and will remain in effect through April 18, 2011.
2. A map identifying the above-described trails is attached to and made part of this Order.
3. Any violation of this order is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, and/or imprisonment for not more than six months [Title 16 USC 551, Title 18 USC 3571(b)(6), Title 18 USC 3581 (b)(7), and/or appropriate State laws].
4. This Order supersedes any previous orders/notices for the above described roads or portions thereof.
