Order No. 03-94-05
Eldorado National Forest
Closure Area
AIRCRAFT USE

Pursuant to **36 CFR 261.50(a)**, the following act is prohibited in order to regulate activities which may affect public safety and resources, within the boundaries of the Eldorado National Forest, under my jurisdiction:

- (1) Landing of aircraft, or dropping or picking up any material, supplies, or person by means of an aircraft, including a helicopter. **36 CFR 261.58(y)**


Pursuant to **36 CFR 261.50(e)**, the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty. **36 CFR 261.50(e)(4)**
2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission. **36 CFR 261.50(e)(1)**

This prohibition is in addition to the General Prohibitions in **36 CFR, Part 261**.

This order is in effect until repealed.
