This order revises and supersedes Order No. 03-93-02, dated February 2, 1993.

Order No. 03-93-02
Eldorado National Forest
Restricted Use
BALDERSTON EQUESTRIAN DAY USE AREA

Pursuant to **36 CFR 261.50(a)**, the following acts are prohibited in the area known as the Balderston Equestrian Day Use Area, as shown on Exhibit A, under my jurisdiction:

- (1) Being in the area after sundown or before sunrise. **36 CFR 261.58(l)**
- (2) Parking or leaving a vehicle in violation of posted instructions. **36 CFR 261.58(g)**

The descriptive location of the Balderston Equestrian Day Use Area is:

Western boundary of the Day Use Area is Wentworth Springs Road. **Northern boundary** of the Day Use Area is the Forest Service property line north of the corral, between Wentworth Springs Road and Balderston Road. **Eastern boundary** of the Day Use Area is Balderston Road, east of the corral. **South side boundary** of the Day Use Area is the entrance road to the Day Area starting from Wentworth Springs Road, to the first horse trail, located on the south side of the entrance road. **Southern boundary continues** on the south side of the said horse trail to Balderston Road.

Pursuant to **36 CFR 261.50(e)**, the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty. **36 CFR 261.50(e)(4)**
2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission. **36 CFR 261.50(e)(1)**

These prohibitions are in addition to the General Prohibitions in **36 CFR, Part 261**.

This order is in effect until repealed.
