This order revises and supersedes Order No. 03-88-03, dated January 25, 1988.

Order No. 03-88-03
Eldorado National Forest
Vehicle Use
EMIGRANT SUMMIT and EMIGRANT LAKE TRAILS

Pursuant to **36 CFR 261.50(b)**, the following act is prohibited on the Emigrant Lake and Emigrant Summit National Recreation Trails from Horse Canyon Saddle to Caples Lake Trailhead, as shown on Exhibit 1, under my jurisdiction:

- (1) Using any type of vehicle on the forest development trails **36 CFR 261.55(b)** including bicycles.


Pursuant to **36 CFR 261.50(e)**, the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty. **36 CFR 261.50(e)(4)**
2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission. **36 CFR 261.50(e)(1)**

This prohibition is in addition to the General Prohibitions in **36 CFR, Part 261**.


This order is in effect until repealed.
