This order revises and supersedes Order No. 03-86-02, dated June 16, 1986.

Occupancy and Use
STUMPY MEADOWS BOAT RAMP/PARKING AREA
OVERNIGHT CAMPING

Pursuant to **36 CFR 261.50(a)**, the following acts are prohibited at the Stumpy Meadows Boat Ramp/Parking Area, as shown in Exhibit 1, under my jurisdiction:

- (1) Parking or leaving a vehicle in violation of posted instruction. **36 CFR 261.58(g)**


Pursuant to **36 CFR 261.50(e)**, the following persons are exempted from this order:

1. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty. **36 CFR 261.50(e)(4)**
2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission. **36 CFR 261.50(e)(1)**

These prohibitions are in addition to the General Prohibitions in **36 CFR, Part 261**.

This order is in effect until repealed.


