This order revises and supersedes Order No. 03-84-02, dated April 19, 1984.

Eldorado National Forest
Restricted Use
PIPI CAMPGROUND

Pursuant to **36 CFR 261.50(a)**, the following act is prohibited within the area known as PiPi Campground and Day Use Area, located within the North 1/2 corner of the North 1/2 corner of Section 9, Township 8 North, Range 14 East, Mt. Diablo Base & Meridian (MDB&M), as shown in Exhibit 1, under my jurisdiction:

- (1) Going into or being upon the area which is closed for the protection of public health and safety **36 CFR 261.53(e)** specifically, operating motorized suction dredges in and adjacent to the previously described location which is a portion of the Middle Fork Cosumnes River which is located upstream of the PiPi Bridge.

Pursuant to **36 CFR 261.50(e)**, the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Any Federal, State or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty. **36 CFR 261.50(e)(4)**
2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission. **36 CFR 261.50(e)(1)**

This prohibition is in addition to the General Prohibitions in **36 CFR, Part 261**.

This order is in effect until repealed.
