This order revises and supersedes Order No. 03-78-04, dated May 2, 1978.

Order No. 03-78-04
Eldorado National Forest
Restricted Use
STUMPY MEADOWS AREA

Pursuant to **36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b)**, the following acts are prohibited outside of developed recreation sites and designated overnight camping areas, at the Stumpy Meadows Restricted Use Area, as shown in Exhibit 1, under my jurisdiction:

- (1) Camping **36 CFR 261.58(e)** (*defined as the temporary use of National Forest Systems lands for the purpose of overnight occupancy without a permanently fixed structure 36 CFR 261.2*)
- (2) Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire, campfire, or stove fire. **36 CFR 261.52(a)**
- (3) Possessing or using a vehicle off forest development roads. **36 CFR 261.56**
- (4) Being on forest development roads **36 CFR 261.54(e)** closed to public use.
- (5) Being on forest development trails **36 CFR 261.55(a)** closed to public use.


Pursuant to **36 CFR 261.50(e)**, the following persons are exempted from this order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty. **36 CFR 261.50(e)(4)**
2. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission. **36 CFR 261.50(e)(1)**

These prohibitions are in addition to the General Prohibitions in **36 CFR, Part 261**.

This order is in effect until repealed.
