ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR
ORDER NUMBER 08-13-04-10-22

Pursuant to the provisions of 16 U.S.C., Section 551 and Title 36 C.F.R. 261.50(a) the following acts are prohibited within the specified area.

**STUBBLEFIELD FISHING PIER
SAM HOUSTON NATIONAL FOREST**

- 1. POSSESSION OF AN OPEN CONTAINER OF A BEVERAGE, WHICH IS DEFINED AS AN ALCOHOLIC BY STATE LAW WITHIN 100 FEET OF FISHING PIER. 36 CFR 261.58(bb)**
- 2. FISHING WITH MORE THAN 3 FISHING POLES. 36 CFR 261.58(v)**
- 3. BUILDING OR USING A FIRE WITHIN 100 FEET OF FISHING PIER. 36 CFR 261.52(a)**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

This order is effective from September 1, 2010, and ending August 31, 2015.

Violation of the prohibition set forth above is punishment by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment of not more than six (6) months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571.
