ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR
ORDER NUMBER SH-08/41

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and for the protection of public health and safety and resources, the following act(s) is prohibited within the specified area(s). This order is effective from September 4, 2008 and ending August 31, 2013.

BIG CREEK SCENIC AREA
SAM HOUSTON NATIONAL FOREST

- 1. Camping 36 CFR 261.58(e)**
- 2. Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire, campfire or stove fire. 36 CFR 261.52(a)**
- 3. Possessing or transporting any part of a green tree or plant. 36 CFR 261.58(t)**
- 4. Littering and dumping. 36 CFR 261.11(d)(e)**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violation of the prohibition set forth above is punishment by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment of not more than six (6) months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571.

- 5. Using a bicycle or motorized vehicle other than in parking area.

- 6. Possessing or using a saddle, pack ore draft animal.
36 CFR 261.55(c)**
- 7. Hunting and trapping. 36 CFR 261.58(v)**
- 8. Possession of dogs. 36 CFR 261.58(s)**
