ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR **ORDER NUMBER 08-13-01-09-04**

Pursuant to the provisions of 16 U.S.C., Section 551 and Title 36 C.F.R. 261.50(a) the following acts are prohibited within the specified area. Upper Angelina River Area. The area in question is shown on the attached map.

- 1. Camping is prohibited.**
36 CFR 261.58(e)
- 2. Possessing or consuming a beverage, which State Law defines as an alcoholic beverage is prohibited.**
36 CFR 261.58(bb)
- 3. Being in the area after sunset or before sunrise is prohibited.**
36 CFR 261.58 (l)
- 4. Possession of glass containers in any portion of the area.**
36 CFR 261.53(e)

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violation of the prohibition set forth above is punishment by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment of not more than six (6) months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571.
