ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR
ORDER NUMBER GL-08/34

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a) and (b), and 36 C.F.R. § 261.53(e) and for the protection of the public and natural resources and for the protection of public safety, the following act(s) is prohibited within the identified units the Caddo National Grasslands in Texas. This order is effective from July 15, 2008 through July 14, 2013.

Caddo National Grasslands Lake Fannin Units 35, 36, 37, 38, and 39 Located in Fannin County (see attached map)

Prohibition: The hunting of all wildlife using any means is prohibited within Lake Fannin Units 35, 36, 37, 38 and 39 in the Caddo National Grasslands in Fannin County, Texas. 36 C.F.R. § 261.58 (v). A map showing the location of the areas where the prohibition is applicable is attached.

Definitions: For the purposes of this Prohibition and the Exceptions:

- (1) "**Hunting**" or "**hunt**" means capture, trap, take or kill, or an attempt to capture, trap, take or kill.
- (2) "**Take**" means collect, hook, hunt, net, shoot, or snare, by any means, and includes an attempt to take or to pursue in order to take.
- (3) "**Small game**" means all mammals and birds except for whitetail deer and feral hogs.

Exceptions: (1) A hunter may only use archery equipment (i.e., long bow, recurved bow, or compound bow) to hunt whitetail deer or feral hogs if in compliance with Exception No. 4.

(2) A hunter with upper limb disabilities may only use a crossbow to hunt whitetail deer or feral hogs if in compliance with Exception No. 4.

(3) A hunter using a shotgun with no larger than #4 shot may hunt small game.


(4) All hunters using archery equipment or a crossbow or using a shotgun under these exceptions must comply with all laws, rules and regulations prescribed by the Texas Parks and Wildlife Service and Texas law, including, but not limited to, possession of required licenses or tags, possession of doe permits, and observation of state-defined hunting seasons.

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 C.F.R. Part 261, Subpart A.



Violation of the prohibition set forth above is punishment by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment of not more than six (6) months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571.
