ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR
ORDER NUMBER NFG-07/32

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(a) and (b), and for the protection of public health and safety and resources, the following act(s) is prohibited within the specified area(s). This order is effective from October 4, 2007 and ending October 5, 2012.

This Prohibition applies to all National Forests & Grasslands in Texas.

- 1. Placing or leaving a hunting stand on the Forests or Grasslands for more than 72 hours is prohibited. For the purpose of this Order, a “hunting stand” includes any structure or device used to elevate, camouflage or hide a person so that wildlife may be hunted or observed. 36 CFR 261.58 (v)**
- 2. Hunting from a hunting stand, which has been in place for more than 72 hours, is prohibited. 36 CFR 251. 58 (v)**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

Violation of the prohibition set forth above is punishment by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment of not more than six (6) months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571.
