ORDER OF FOREST SUPERVISOR
ORDER NUMBER 08-13-00-10-13

Pursuant to the provisions of 16 U.S.C., Section 551 and Title 36 C.F.R. 261.50(a) the following acts are prohibited within the specified area.

**WILDLIFE MANAGEMENT AREAS LOCATED ON THE
NATIONAL FORESTS AND GRASSLANDS IN TEXAS
IN**

**Fannin, Montgomery, Sabine, San Augustine, San Jacinto, Trinity, and Walker
Counties, Texas**

- 1. Possessing a Loaded Firearm within or on a motor vehicle (except concealed handgun permit holders). CFR 261.58 V.**
- 2. Possessing a loaded firearm within a designated campsite, designated vehicle parking area, designated boat launching facility, Texas Parks and Wildlife or U. S. Forest Service Check Station, and designated Archery only areas. CFR 261.58 V.**
- 3. Being under the influence of alcohol or consumes alcoholic beverages while engaged in hunting activities, or publicly consumes or displays an alcoholic beverage. CFR 261.28 bb.**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

These prohibitions are in addition to the general prohibitions in 36 CFR Part 261, Subpart A.

This order is effective from September 12, 2010, and ending September 11, 2015.

Violation of the prohibition set forth above is punishment by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual and \$10,000 for an organization or imprisonment of not more than six (6) months, or both. 16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571.
