

USE OF VEHICLES OFF FOREST DEVELOPMENT ROADS
UMATILLA NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36 CFR Sec. 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area, trails and roads, described in this order within the Umatilla National Forest, until further notice.

- (1) Possessing or using a motorized vehicle off Forest Development roads during the period of November 21st to April 29th. 36 CFR 261.56
- (2) Using any motorized vehicles on Forest Development roads listed, during the period of November 21st to April 29th. 36 CFR 261.54(a)
- (3) Using any motorized vehicles on Forest Development trails during the period of November 21st to April 29th. CFR 261.55(b)

Pursuant to 36 CFR Sec. 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

- (1) Persons with a permit.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local officer or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in performance of an official duty.
- (3) Spout Springs Special Use Permittee in the operation and management of business within the winter sports permit area.

Road, Trail, and Area Description

- (1) All roads within the closed area.
- (2) All trails within the closed area except the designated snowmobile trail shown on Exhibit "A".
- 3) The closed area closed to motorized use is that land bounded by a line beginning at the junction of Forest Road #3700060 and State Highway #204, in Section 10, T.3N., R.38E.; thence southeasterly along the east side of Highway #204 to the Balloon Tree Springs Road #3725; thence along Forest Road #3725 to the junction with Forest Road #3725020; thence along Forest Road #3725020 to a point approximately 1/4 mile south and 1/4 mile west of the section corner between Sections 11, 12, 13, and 14; thence due east to the section line between Sections 14 and 13; thence north on the section line between Sections 14 and 13, and between Sections 11 and 12 for approximately 1/2 mile to the ridgetop overlooking Lookingglass Creek; thence northwesterly along the ridgetop forming the Lookingglass Creek drainage to the county line between Union and Umatilla counties; thence south on the county line to the junction with State Highway #204; thence southeasterly along the east side of Highway #204 to the junction with Forest Road #3700060, the point of beginning. Although the downhill ski area lies within this described closure area, it does not come under the restrictions of this closure. Regulation of motorized use within the downhill ski area is covered by a separate order (#83-15). A snowmobile

corridor will exist on the powerline right-of-way that runs parallel to the east side of State Highway #204. SEE ATTACHED MAP. (EXHIBIT A)
