

ORDER

USE OF VEHICLES OFF FOREST DEVELOPMENT ROADS

UMATILLA NATIONAL FOREST

Pursuant to 36CFR Section 261.50(a) and (b), the following acts are prohibited on the area and roads described in this order within the Umatilla National Forest until further notice.

- (1) Possession or use of a motor vehicle on forest development roads during the period of December 1st to March 31st. 36CFR 261.54(a).
- (2) Possession or use of a motor vehicle off forest development roads during the period of December 1st to March 31st. 36CFR 261.56.

Pursuant to 36CFR Section 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order.

- (1) Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.
- (2) Any Federal, State, or local official, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in the performance of an official duty.


AREA DESCRIPTION

Area is the boundary of the Andies Prairie Sledding Area and Winter Camping Area in Section 26, T3N, R38E as shown on the attached map (Exhibit A).

ROAD DESCRIPTION

Forest Development Road 3727 from State Highway 204 (milepost 0.0) to its intersection with the Andies Prairie snowmobile trail (milepost 0.70).

Done at Pendleton, Oregon this 1st day of December, 2000.



