Placer County Water Agency to Continue Work at French Meadows Reservoir - Mosquito Ridge Road Being Plowed for Access

Slide on Mosquito Ridge Road Restricts Travel to One Lane

The spillway at French Meadows Reservoir is being expanded to accommodate potential flood level flows. This work is scheduled to occur between April 2010 to June 2012.

This spring, snowmobiling may be affected as Placer County Water Agency's contractor KIWCO, removes snow from the Mosquito Ridge Road to provide access to the project facilities. Snowmobile ramps will be installed at the intersection of the Mosquito Ridge Road and the Robinson Flat/Duncan Peak Road to allow snowmobiles to cross the road. Ramps will also be provided at the south end of the dam and west of the dam on Forest Service Road #22.

The Mosquito Ridge Road is gated near the Interbay to permit snow plows to complete their work. The road will remain gated until the Forest Service determines that conditions are safe for public use and snow level on intersecting roads is reduced. Additionally, a slide on the Mosquito Ridge Road near milepost 18 restricts travel to one lane. The slide and road are being actively monitored for movement.
