Come learn about the background and purpose of County Resource Advisory Committees (RAC) and how they can provide funding for watershed improvement, fuel reduction, and other natural resource improvement projects that benefit Shasta-Trinity National Forest lands in Shasta, Siskiyou, Tehama and Trinity County.

The workshop will cover RAC legislation and upcoming reauthorizations, RAC application requirements, and the process and requirements for receiving funding on awarded projects. Representatives from local RACs and the Forest Service will be present to provide information and answer questions.

Forest Service representatives will be available from 5:00-7:00 to review draft RAC proposals to insure they meet proposal requirements and to answer questions about the RAC process. Participants are encouraged to bring a paper copy of their draft proposal for review.
