

Not R2 Sensitive Species and Not of Concern

Recommendations and Evaluations

Common Name: Silver Chub

Scientific Name: *Macrhybopsis storeriana*

Recommendation: Not R2 SS and not of concern

Recommendation Rationale:

The species is widespread in eastern North America. In R2, it occurs in southeastern South Dakota (state ranking imperiled) and Nebraska (state ranking apparently secure). It does not occur in the southwestern portion of Kansas. There is no information that demonstrates any presence on NFS lands. Typically inhabits large, often silty rivers, and feeds at or near the bottom on insects, crustaceans, and mollusks. It is uncertain whether the species even occurs on NFS lands, and no threats associated with FS management were identified.
