SPECIAL RESTRICTIONS FOR SUGARLOAF FOREST DEVELOPED ROAD 402

**PROHIBITIONS**

Pursuant to 16 USC 551 and 36 CFR 261.50 (a) and (b), the following acts and omissions are prohibited on the areas and roads as described in this Order, and as depicted on the attached map hereby incorporated into this Order as Exhibit A (the "restricted area"), all within the Mesa Ranger District, Tonto National Forest, Maricopa County, Arizona:

1. Going into or being upon an area, Public health and safety. 36 CFR 261.53e

**EXEMPTIONS**

Pursuant to 36 CFR 261.50 (e), the following persons are exempt from this Order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of any organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Any Rawlings Construction employee or contractor being contracted by the Arizona Department of Transportation.

**AREA DESCRIBED**

The restricted area includes all National Forest System lands and roads within the exterior boundaries of the Sugarloaf road (FDR 402), Tonto National Forest, as depicted in Exhibit A of this Order. Sugarloaf Road (FDR 402) is located in T4N, R8E, Section 23, NW. Starting from the intersection of Highway 87 and Forest Developed Road 402, following the roadway northwest for 0.5 mile encompassing 300 feet along both sides of the roadbed.

**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this order is the protection of National Forest visitors, employees and contractors, the prevention of user conflicts, the conservation of natural resources, and the protection of property belonging to the United States. This Order will be in effect until the installation of a double swing Protector Gate is complete.

**IMPLEMENTATION**

1. Prohibitions contained in this order become effective beginning Monday, May 16, 2011, and will remain in effect until Tuesday, May 17, 2011. Restrictions are in effect during daylight periods (05:00-19:00), unless terminated sooner.

2. These restrictions are in addition to the general prohibitions found at 36 CFR 261, Subpart A.
3. Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for individuals and \$10,000 for organizations, imprisonment for not more than six (6) months, or both. [16 USC 551, 18 USC 3559, 3571 and 3581].
