Forest Supervisor's Order

Pursuant to Title 36 Code of Federal Regulation 261.50(b), the following acts are prohibited as described below, within the Jefferson Ranger District on the Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest. This temporary restriction is in addition to those enumerated in Subpart A, Part 261, Title 36, Code of Federal Regulations and will remain in effect from **June 3, 2011** until **the road is repaired and the order is rescinded**.

36 CFR 261.54 – National Forest System Roads:

It is prohibited to use “Any type of vehicle prohibited by the order.”(Title 36 CFR 261.54(a)).

For the purpose of this order the road described as Forest Service Road #1538 (Haystack Road) is closed to all motorized vehicles for public safety and watershed protection and erosion control from June 2, 2011 until the road dries out. The closure area description follows with a map attachment.

Area Description:

Description of the road – FS road # 1538 (Haystack Road) beginning in the SW1/4SW1/4, Section 21, T. 5 N., R. 6 W. and continuing north and east on FS road #1538 for approximately 1.1 miles to the Haystack Trailhead in the NW1/4NW1/4, Section 21, T.5 N., R. 7 W.

Exemptions:

Pursuant to Title 36 CFR 261.50(e), the following are exempt from this restriction:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.
3. Any other person meeting exemption requirements specified in the order.

Penalty:

Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$5,000 for an individual or \$10,000 for an organization, or imprisonment for not more than 6 months, or both (16 USC 551 and 18 USC 3559 and 3571).
