FOREST ORDER

Occupancy and Use Restrictions

Pursuant to 16 U.S.C. § 551, and 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(a), the following acts are prohibited within the **Greater Picket Wire Canyonlands Area**, which is hereby described as those National Forest System lands located in the 6th PM, Otero and Las Animas Counties, Colorado:

Township 27 South, Range 55 West, 6th PM, Otero County, Colorado:

All of sections 31, 32, 33 and 34 and portions of Sections 20, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29 and 35, including Forest System Roads 2185, 2185.A, 2185.B, and 2186 (the access roads to Withers Canyon Trailhead and Picket Wire Canyonlands rim) and the developed Withers Canyon Trailhead Area, as shown in Exhibit A.

Township 28 South, Range 55 West, 6th PM, Las Animas County, Colorado:

All of Sections 19, 30 and 31 and portions of Sections 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9, 17, 18, 29 and 32.

Township 28 South, Range 56 West, 6th PM, Las Animas County, Colorado:

All of Sections 25, 35 and 36 and portions of Sections 13, 14, 23, 24, 26, 27 and 34.

Township 29 South, Range 55 West, 6th PM, Las Animas County, Colorado:

Portions of Sections 5 and 6.

Township 29 South, Range 56 West, 6th PM, Las Animas County, Colorado:

Portions of Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 7, 8, 9, 10 and 18.

The Greater Picket Wire Canyonlands Area is depicted on the attached map, hereby incorporated into this order as Exhibit A. The order is needed to assure public health and safety during the Callie Mare Wildland Fire, and while an assessment of hazardous conditions caused by the Callie Mare Wildland Fire is conducted within the restricted area.

PROHIBITIONS:

1. Going into or being upon the **Greater Picket Wire Canyonlands Area**. (36 CFR 261.53(e))

EXEMPTIONS:

Pursuant to 36 C.F.R. § 261.50(e), the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a Forest Service permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act or omission.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force, in the performance of an official duty.

This order will be in effect from the date it is signed, and continue through December 31, 2011, or until rescinded, whichever event occurs first.
