

# Northern Rockies Interagency Cache Policy

## Inventory Draw Down

2002

### General Policy

Northern Rockies Interagency Support Cache (MTNRK) strives to support all emergency incidents regardless of agency association, type of emergency or location, provided such support does not compromise its primary mission. The primary mission is to support fire suppression in the Northern Rockies Geographic Area. In so far as that mission is met, remaining supplies are available to the general good of emergency response.

In the event that emergency response activities outside of the Northern Rockies Geographic Area incur a demand for MTNRK supplies, the following guidelines will be used to determine the minimum level of inventory to be reserved for Northern Rockies use. The Supply Management Officer, or its Acting, *may* draw down inventory below 50% reserve on a case-by-case basis, but only after thorough situation analysis, consultation with staff and Northern Rockies cache managers and input from the Northern Rockies Coordinator.

Northern Rockies Planning Level	Minimum Reserved For NR Use
I, II and III	50%
IV	75%
V	100%
