Personal Convenience Non Use:

As discussed on March 23, 2011 with Monte Topmiller, your request for Personal Convenience (P-C) Non-Use for the 2011 grazing season has been granted. Please be mindful of the following points:

- P-C Non-Use is authorized on a *yearly basis* and *if granted*, is not to exceed 3 years. As per FSM 2231.61 (Gila Supp #23), I am informing you that this is your third and final year of Personal Convenience Non-Use. In order to maintain full permitted numbers you are required to stock at least 90% of the permitted numbers by the 4th year (2012). If you do not stock to within 90% of the permitted numbers at any time during the 2012 grazing season, the Permit will be reduced to the level of use made of it during the fourth and final grazing season.
- When P-C Non-Use is authorized, we reserve the right to allow other grazing permittees to utilize the forage on the allotment.
- When P-C Non-Use is authorized, all assigned range developments identified in the Term Grazing Permit will be maintained to a functional status.

It is incumbent upon me to reiterate the seriousness of stocking in 2012. If the allotment is not stocked (to at least 90% of permitted numbers) during the 2012 grazing season, the permit will be reduced to the number of livestock stocked that year's grazing season.
